U.S. Term Limits Launches Commercial Campaign in AZ Against Term Limits Repeal Legislation

January 28th, 2010, Fairfax, VA—U.S. Term Limits President Philip Blumel today announced that his organization would be running a 30-second commercial in Arizona “to keep residents fully informed as to what their elected lawmakers are doing to kill term limits in Arizona.”

Legislative term limits were originally enacted in 1992 when Arizonans voted with 74 percent of the vote to add them to the state’s constitution. The current law limits members from serving more than four consecutive two-year terms on the State House and four consecutive two-year terms on the State Senate, and took effect in 2000.
